



Amazing Animals - Pets Cruise into Kindergarten Playscape

***Come explore our play and learn area:
One, Two, Three, Play with Me!***

1. Follow your child's lead while exploring the different activities and use natural opportunities to extend language and concepts. For example, if your child chooses to start playing with the Pet Vet Center, "Look at the checklist for a vet to check a puppy dog's health! The vet should look at the puppy's eyes and tongue. What else does the picture show us?"
2. Let your child choose one of the books for you to read aloud. As you share the book, connect the story, characters, or concepts to the materials you have been playing with together. For example, "This book is about a cat named Cookie. Since the title is *Cookie's Week*, I guess it will be about all the things she does in a week. I wonder if she will go to the vet in the story. Let's find out!" Your child may also enjoy using the toys in this playscape to make up a story about pets.
3. Build scissor skills with the animal shapes or other cutting practice activities we have provided. Help your child and "share the scissors" as needed to keep it fun!
